JCPS schools participating in the *Chain Reaction of Kindness* can collect both funds and food – specifically, cereal boxes – to support our 67 food pantries housed in JCPS schools, serving students and their families.

Additionally, you can use this project to advance learning in a myriad of ways and develop students' Backpack of Success Skills! Have a fun idea? Please share, and we'll add to our running list of ideas on the *Chain Reaction of Kindness* webpage so we can share across the entire district.

A team member from Dare to Care will deliver the small, monetary donation boxes to your school one week before the start of your drive (suggested 1 box per classroom) and will pick donations up when you notify us you are ready for a pickup. We can also pickup cereal boxes for schools that collect 25 boxes or less. For larger amounts, we request that you deliver the donations to the Dare to Care warehouse at 5803 Fern Valley Road, or to the Community Kitchen at 1200 South 28<sup>th</sup> Street, Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. till 2:00 p.m.
